Skyward Wellness Checks—Directions (Week 2/3)

Students must have a Wellness Check done before coming to school. The paper copy on the learning plan can be used as a backup, but our goal now is to have the Wellness Screening done on Skyward by ALL of our families. At 7:50, a report is emailed directly to the teachers, so please do the online or mobile app check done before 7:50.

For parents who are not using this quick and easy tool yet:

1. **Get your Skyward account fully set up online**. Click this link or use your camera phone to scan the code and get to the APA Skyward sign in page. Enter your user name and password.

(Your user name is almost always your first initial and last name. Example: Kelly Smith = ksmith) If this is your first time getting on (or you have forgotten your

password) you will need to have your password reset. Please call or email Ms. Gamez (Spanish/English) or Mrs. Leavitt (English) (mgamez@apamail.org / lleavitt@apamail.org) and we can confirm your username and reset your password.

2. **Download the free Skyward Mobile App** from the App Store.

In the App Store, search for "Skyward Mobile Access" Choose Skyward Mobile...Education and click "get" Open the app and enter your username and password. The Wellness Screening will be the first thing that pops up.

Academic Highlight: Reading University

Reading University (RU) is an academic program that introduces students to value-based literature and informational texts, and strengthens vocabulary through independent reading. The goal of the Reading University program to instill a love for independent reading in each of our students.

General Rules and Information about Reading University:

- Each term, students will read a specified number of books from the Reading University (RU) list.
- Students are allowed to choose one book NOT on the RU list each term.*
- The books for checkout in the classroom libraries are all books from the RU list.
- Students may read books from the RU list *at* their grade level, one grade level *below*, or at any level *above* their grade level.
- Students in all grades may count books that are read to them outside of school.*
 (Books read to student in school do not qualify for RU credit.)
- Students may re-read a book for credit, but not during the same school year.*
- *RU guidelines are adapted based on feedback from Parent Surveys.

Students will receive a grade on their report card for Reading University, based on the number of books they read and submitted on their RU Log. The Reading University Log can be found in the student's docket in the gray Reading University folder. Students write the title of the book and the date it was finished. The parent then signs the log verifying that the book was read. Reading University logs are turned in to the homeroom teacher at the end of each term. Term 1 Reading University logs are due Monday, September 28.

Uniform Reminder: Masks and Boots
