## Covid Reminders (Week 2 of 2)

Thank you, parents, for paying attention to your student's health on a daily basis—and keeping them home when they are unwell. Just as a reminder, if you have your student tested for Covid19, always keep them home until you have the results. If your student tests positive, please inform the school as quickly as possible so we can minimize exposure and quickly inform the parents of any students who may be affected, so they may take proper precautions at home. Remember, we are able to do rapid testing at school for our WV1 students and staff. To request this, follow these procedures:

1. Go to the Redcap website to register your student (or yourself), which is found at <u>testapa.com</u>. Redcap is the state's official COVID19 testing site. Choose your campus, and then fill out the form, registering your student (or



yourself if you are a staff member). Once someone is registered, they will remain on the Redcap system and will not need to register again.

#### Reminder about Boots & Jackets (Week 2 of 2)

From October through March, K-6 girls have the option of wearing low heeled, solid black dress boots as foot wear. They should bring PE shoes to change into on their PE days.

On cold or snowy days, students may wear any style boots *to and from school* and *out to recess*, but should bring their school shoes to wear during the day.

The same goes for jackets. Students may wear any jackets to and from school and out to recess. In class, students will need to wear a navy blue sweater if they desire an additional layer.
